Proposed Revisions:

- Stronger adherence to the prevailing depth of existing dwellings and building line including the positioning of ancillary buildings e.g. garages.
- ★ Protection and extension of recreational walking and cycling routes.
- ★ Traffic hazard identification and support for a separate traffic-calming plan.
- **★** Continuing improvements to existing green spaces and recreation areas.
- ★ Provision for toddler & young children's play closer to the south of the village.
- ★ Minimising the impact of any development on wildlife & environment.
- **★** Developments to deliver a minimum biodiversity net gain of 10%.
- Greater encouragement of well-designed renewable energy & energy efficiency measures, including solar panels, in the Conservation Area.
- ★ Developments to demonstrate prevention of surface water flooding.
- Reduction of light pollution by ensuring that outdoor lighting makes use of appropriate and low energy lighting technologies.
- ★ Enabling flexible use of community buildings & spaces by micro businesses.
